My Fax from the 20.1.2010 and our Meeting in Jerusalem on the 11.2.2010
Information concerning your Son, Missing Soldier Guy Hever

Dear Rina,

it was a great honour and pleasure for me to come to know you personally last Thursday here in Jerusalem.
I could really see how your spirit was coming back to life while listening to my report about my meeting with your son Guy in Syria as the Tanach is telling us about Jaakov when he heard that his son Josef was still alive. It was like you also said: "Enough, I want to see him!"

As it was your wish, I want to confirm now in a few sentences what I have said to you during our conversation:

I met your son, missing soldier Guy Hever, during an interrogation on the Third of May 2005 around 22.00 o'clock at night in Damascus/Syria with 90% certainty. Of course I can not say "100%" because his name was not mentioned.

The Syrians used Guy in the beginning of this 5-hour-interrogation to ask me questions in Hebrew. 25-30 partly very important people were at that time present in the well-furnished room. Out of observations I know exactly the place in Damascus where we met and where I was afterwards imprisoned.

First I thought it was Ron Arad. At that time I didn't know anything about Guy and his fate. But when I saw afterwards photos from Ron Arad I knew for sure it was not him. Nobody told me about missing soldier Guy Hever.

Only about two years later when I made a computer-course in Berlin/Germany and was surfing in the Internet I found by chance on the 16.2.2007 a newspaper-article from the 14.2.2007 about the fate of Guy Hever including a photo from him. Immediately I knew it was him I had met on the 3.5.2005 during my main-interrogation in Damascus.

I have given all information directly afterwards further but obviously it was not taken serious and had not been transferred to you, Rina, as Guy's mother.

That's all what I want to say now. I hope this information is helping you to get your son back from Syria, even now after more than 4 years. Don't give this letter or information to the Media!!!
As I have told you, I am willing to go with you to the Police, the General Security Services or other Government Institutions to be further interviewed because that's the straight and therefore best way.
