I have been acquainted with Guy HEVER's family in 1999, a year and half after he disappeared near his military base in the Golan Heights.


Ambassador Eitan Benzur, at that time Director General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, asked me then to coordinate the Ministry's efforts to help search for Guy, in the framework of my duty as Director of the Syrian and Lebanon Division.

After thoroughly studying the case, we decided to center our efforts in mobilizing humanitarian international organizations and high-level friendly personalities to help us check the possibility of Guy HEVER being incarcerated in a syrian jail.

Up to now, the Syrian response to our indirect request for information was negative.

We believe that this effort toward the Syrian authorities must continue. Any further help from International Organization and people of good will is most welcome and will contribute to maintain our efforts to find the young Israeli soldier who disappeared 4 years ago.
